Sections 5, 6, and 8 could provide a savings as the federal government will pick up 50 percent of extended benefit payments.

The combinations of rapidly changing state and national economic conditions, coupled with federal and state job insurance legislation, makes it impossible to project extended benefit cost impacts one and two years from now.

Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, and 7 are anticipated to have little or no fiscal impact.
