Narrative:

It is estimated that SB 2233 will generate \$904,180 in additional gaming revenue for distribution to the cities and counties.

In terms of funding for the Attorney General's office, the Governor's budget would have to be increased by \$1,000,840; \$520,390 for the Gaming Division (\$395,390 for enforcement, \$125,000 (estimated) for work permit administration), and \$480,450 for the Bureau of Criminal Investigation. This would permit the State to enforce the present gaming rules and regulations, and those required by SB 2233.
