Narrative:

Senate Bill 2342, if enacted into law as amended by the Senate on page 373 of the Senate Journal, will appropriate monies from the Oil Trust Fund to a Water Development Sinking Fund and will have no other fiscal effect during the 1983-85 biennium. Beginning July 1, 1985, one sixth of the oil extraction monies allocated to the State General Fund under the current distribution formula will be allocated to the Oil Trust Fund, a portion of which will be allocated to the Water Development Sinking Fund. The total amount of the appropriation from the Oil Trust Fund during the 1983-85 biennium cannot be calculated from data available to the Tax Department. Income to the Oil Trust Fund during the 1983-85 biennium is estimated to be approximately \$12,500,000.

This fiscal note is based on the oil and gas tax revenue projections presented to the Legislature on February 11, 1983.


