In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this measure:

Narrative: This bill proposes to eliminate the \$225 per mile tax on transmission lines owned by cooperative power companies and impose an ad valorem property tax. There are currently 1,431.39 miles of transmission lines with a capacity of 230 KV or larger that would be affected. We do not presently receive reports of cost or value of these lines so an estimate has been made of the value based upon reports from investor-owned electric companies. If enacted, we estimate that the fiscal effect would be from \$300,000 to \$450,000 additional revenue in the 1984-85 fiscal year. We are unable to allocate that revenue between the state, counties and cities.
