Narrative:

SB 2443 proposes to allow local assessment for five years of property that has changed from non-operating to operating property. If enacted, SB 2443 would have a negligible fiscal effect to the state special fund for the medical center. There is no fiscal effect to the state general fund.

We are not able to estimate the fiscal effect to counties or cities because we cannot predict how much property will change from non-operating to operating.
