Narrative:

House Bill No. 1108 will have no fiscal effect on the state, counties, or cities. The effect of the bill would be merely to place the ownership of data processing equipment with the purchasing agency rather than with Central Data Processing. Agencies then would retain title to the equipment and record its existence on their equipment inventories. All other aspects of the relationship between Central Data Processing and state agencies would remain the same.
