Narrative:

The proposed legislation permits a maximum fee of \$15.00 for an annual pass which allows entrance to all state parks during that particular year and a maximum fee of \$2.00 for a daily pass which allows entrance to a state park(s) during that day.

The fiscal effect in dollars to the state park operating fund of increased rates - not necessarily to the maximum levels - can be estimated in the executive budget recommendation for park operations revenue of \$700,000 for the 1985-87 biennium over the park operations revenue of \$526,400 for the 1983-85 biennium. This estimated increase of \$173,600 in additional revenue to the park operating fund decreases the need for a like amount from the general fund.


