

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED CHANGES TO  
LEGISLATIVE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT

The following schedule details the fiscal impact during the 49th and 50th Legislative Assemblies of the proposed changes to legislative compensation and expense reimbursement as contained in engrossed House Bill No. 1243.

Changes in expense reimbursement and salary to members of the 49th and 50th Legislative Assemblies:

<u>Legislative Assembly</u>	<u>Estimated Cost</u>
Provide non-Bismarck legislators expense reimbursement at a maximum of \$30/night - limited to \$600/month: <u>1/</u>	
49th Legislative Assembly	\$348,150
50th Legislative Assembly	440,150
Increase legislative leadership and chairmen compensation to <u>1/</u> \$10/day and \$5/day, respectively: <u>1/</u>	
49th Legislative Assembly	6,340
50th Legislative Assembly	<u>6,340</u>
