Narrative:

HB 1540 as introduced will have no negative fiscal impact on the State General Fund. However, the provisions of this bill may require the services of a one-half time FTE clerk position to categorize and compile the information required. With adequate cooperation from other state agencies, it does not appear that the provisions of this bill would otherwise present a significant administrative burden to the Workmen's Compensation Bureau.

The provisions of this bill may help assure that employer accounts are established in a timely manner to provide insurance protection under the Workmen's Compensation Act for both North Dakota employees and employers.

If HB 1540 was amended so that the Office of Management and Budget, Division of Records Management was responsible for compilation and categorization of licenses, permits and registrations, the Bureau would be able to distribute such information without additional personnel or significant administrative costs.
