In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this measure:

Narrative: Based on payments made on enrollment during the 1983-84 school year and applying the proposed adjustment procedure during the current biennium the impact on the state general fund with the emergency clause attached to the bill would be to reduce the turn-back to the state general fund by approximately \$700,000 during this biennium. By guaranteeing the previous years average daily membership as the minimum basis for adjusting pupil payments which were originally made on the basis of enrollment will reduce the amount recovered from approximately \$2.1 million to about \$1.4 million.

Because recovery dollars were not considered in estimating pupil payments for the 1985-87 biennium it is estimated that House Bill 1549 will have no impact on the state general fund other than to reduce the amount of turn-back to the state general fund by about \$700,000 or \$1.4 million during the 1985-87 biennium.
