Narrative:

According to current law, grain storage condominiums on agricultural land are ruled exempt from the ad valorem tax while grain storage condominiums on non-agricultural land, railroad right-of-ways for example, are held subject to the ad valorem tax. HB 1628, if enacted, would exempt grain storage condominiums on non-agricultural land. We do not have record of the grain storage condominiums that will be effected by this bill and, therefore, we are not able to compute the fiscal effect to cities and counties.


