Narrative:

Senate Bill 2200 is intended to transfer Mobile Home and Modular Unit Permits from 39-18=05 and include them in 39-12-02 along with all other over-dimensional permits. It would also delete the Highway Commissioner's authority to issue oversize permits. It will give the Highway Patrol authority to establish reasonable safety rules in place of the Highway Commissioners Rules and Regulations for vehicles exempt from width limitations.

It will authorize local jurisdictions to collect an appropriate fee for certificates allowing a 10% increase in weight for agricultural products on local roads. The fiscal note to the local jurisdictions is not known.
