Narrative:

If enacted with Conference Committee amendments (adopted 4-1-85) to Second Engrossment, SB 2257 would have a total fiscal effect of -\$6,600,000 to -\$7,500,000 in the 1985-87 biennium. This fiscal effect has been allocated below according to the applicable coal conversion tax distribution formula (65% State General Fund; 35% county).

NOTE: This analysis assumes the bill, if enacted, would become effective with the July 1985 production.
