Narrative:

This bill would require the State of North Dakota to reimburse the counties for the incarceration of individuals from the time that they are bound over to district court from county court and until that person is sentenced (or found innocent).

If the pattern of charged felons would continue and should the average length of stay in the county jails remain about the same, it is estimated that the total additional cost, for the biennium, of reimbursing the counties for the jail expenses total \$1,519,200.00, which sum would have to be appropriated to the Judicial Branch of government through House Bill No. 1027.
