Narrative:

Based on the number of students being tuitioned to schools in neighboring states by North Dakota districts during the 1984-85 school year, it is estimated that the additional impact on the state general fund would be approximately \$150,000 per year or \$300,000 for the biennium.

By eliminating the 20 mill deduct from the calculation of instate tuition, school districts which receive students would loose approximately \$387,000 in revenue per year that they now receive from sending school districts.
