Narrative:

We expect a positive fiscal impact from rate equalization stemming from a decreased charge to private pay patients. This should result in slower consumption of private pay resources thereby delaying the date of Medical Assistance eligibility. We are unable to assess the impact with any degree of certainty because we cannot predict what the private rates will be nor do we have access to resources available to private pay patients at admission.

We request the Bill be referred to the Public Service Commission for an assessment of Sections 4 & 5.
