Narrative:

Revenue generated by the \$20 fee assessed for the provision of criminal history records to non-criminal justice agencies, will be determined by the rules to be established by the Attorney General. There is a great deal of variability in the possible revenues, depending on how the rules are written. A conservative estimate at this time is that approximately 120 non-criminal justice requests can be expected annually (which would fit the criteria for payment of the fee).
