## ATTACHMENT

### State's Responsibilities

With Licensing, the Criminal Justice Training and Statistics Division in the Office of the Attorney General would be administering this program. We would be required to distribute licenses immediately and then continue to do so yearly on a prorated 3-year cycle bases. Additional funding would be required to administer the program to include conducting special hearings/meetings concerning the Peace Officer's Standards and Training Board. It is anticipated that a \$15.00 fee will be assessed over a 3-year period, and an amendment to HB 1052 will request that these fees be returned to the Criminal Justice Training and Statistics Division to administer the program.

### Cities'/Counties' Responsibilities

It is anticipated that 80 new law enforcement officers begin employment in the state each year. Governmental agencies would be required to ensure that newly hired officers would have been administered a physical and psychological examination at a average cost of \$100.00. It is quite possible that each time an agency initiates a selection process more than just the one selected would be administered these examinations. With this in mind, the figure listed should be considered as conservative.

In addition, the licensing fee of \$15.00 would required, and it is unknown as to whether the officer or agency would be responsible for it.
