Narrative:

Based on the 1985-86 transportation payments made by parents the fiscal impact on local school districts would be an estimated \$300,000 per year or \$600,000 for the 2-year period. Because mandated transportation would require all school districts to provide some form of transportation, the fiscal impact to the state would be an estimated \$200,000 per year or \$400,000 for the 2-year period for state transportation payments to school districts.
