Narrative:

The all-terrain vehicle registration is set at \$10 per vehicle. One-half or \$5 goes to the Motor Vehicle Department and one-half or \$5 goes to Parks and Recreation Department. There are presently approximately 2,000 ATV's registered in North Dakota. It is estimated that 9,000 ATV's would be dealer registered in the 1987-89 biennial period. The Parks and Recreation Executive Budget includes \$45,000 in other funds from ATV registration.

A \$10 fee is charged for each person receiving the all-terrain vehicle safety certification. An estimated 200 youths between the ages of 12 and 16 would be certified.
