Narrative:

The exact fiscal impact of House Bill No. 1186 in dollars is not available at this time. We anticipate minor savings in operating costs and slight increases in lease revenues for a few tracts. The amount of savings and additional revenue will depend on the number of tracts involved, determined over a 5 year lease cycle. Savings will occur in advertising and the cost of issuing leases because several small tracts on one side of a highway, road, railroad canal, river, or lake could be combined into one lease under this bill. This should also make these tracts more attractive for potential lessees, thus having a positive effect on lease revenues.
