Narrative:

With respect to the two-year limit on compensation used in the calculation of maximum rehabilitation contracts, fiscal impact would be minimal, if any. However, the possibility of a small savings to the Fund exists. Changes would provide statutory support for current Bureau policy.

The estimated effect of the change in the relocation/remodeling allowance would be a maximum increase of approximately \$35,000 per year for periods subsequent to the effective date. Estimate is based on awards made in prior periods.
