Narrative:

Fee waivers reduce the tuition income realized by the higher education institutions. Reductions in tuition income reduce the ability of the institution to meet its annual operating budget.

The effect of this waiver would be minimal if the bill remains as written. Testimony revealed only 1 to 3 deaths of firefighters or police in the last several years. Given three recipients, the waiver could reach \$10,000 in reduced income for 1987-89, depending upon the final level of tuition set.

The addition of disabled firefighters and police could escalate the reduction in income by a proportionate number.
