Narrative:

HB 1206 is a housecleaning bill that changes the date of issue and the length of time the annual park entrance permit is honored. These changes more closely coincide with the major visitation patterns of the state parks and the availability of personnel to sell the annual permits at the park entrances.

The change of the date of issue is from October to November of the preceding year. The change in length of time is from the preceding October through the entire calendar year (15 months) to from the preceding November through the entire calendar year plus four (4) months of the following year (18 months).

HB 1206 should not have any fiscal impact, but should make it easier for the visitor to obtain an annual pass and will definitely allow better administration of permit sales.
