Narrative:

The fiscal impact of the amendments is that it removes the State's financial responsibility and puts it on the local school district.

The impact to local school districts is estimated to be \$100,000 per year or \$200,000 for the two-year period.

This will reduce the state payment of \$100,000 per year and place the responsibility on school districts for the 18-21 year olds that are mainly those released from Grafton State School.

The figures in brackets show a negative impact to the general fund.
