Narrative:

The fiscal impact of this bill will be to increase the general fund revenue by \$19,216 and to increase the county revenue by \$44,836 for a total increased revenue of \$64,052 for the biennium, due to Section 1; Subsection 4 and to Section 2. There is no fiscal impact from the remaining portion of the bill. The revenue will be generated as a result of mandating that the court enter an order against one or both parties of the court ordered child custody investigation for the costs of such investigation except in indigent cases. This does not pertain to child protection service or child abuse and neglect investigations.


