Narrative:

The negative effect to the foundation aid appropriation of reducing the weighting factor to districts A.D.M. instead of school plant would be \$329,950 per year if the current 1986-87 plant enrollments stay the same.

Increasing the alternative high school weighting factors to 1.7 would have a fiscal impact of about \$100,000 per year if all schools currently offering alternative programs continue and do not increase enrollments.
