Narrative:

SB 2024 establishes an insurance regulatory trust fund which will be made up of fees that are charged by the Insurance Department and interest income earned on the fund. These fees are currently deposited in the general fund, so this change will result in a \$2,145,000 loss of revenues to the general fund and an increase in special fund revenues of a like amount.

Please note that this general fund revenue loss is taken into consideration in the executive 1987-89 revenue forecast.

Also, Section 11 of this bill increases the salary of the insurance commissioner from \$46,000 to \$47,520. This salary increase is effective July 1, 1988, and is included in the appropriation for the insurance commissioner. The total impact is an increase of \$1,725 in special fund appropriations.
