Narrative:

REVENUE: This bill essentially changes the gaming tax computation from 5% of the adjusted gross proceeds to 1% of the gross proceeds, and creates a state gaming enforcement fund.

The bill's gaming tax computation would result in \$2,322,600 being received as revenue during the biennium for the state gaming enforcement fund. The general fund would decrease by \$1,977,036 which is the amount of revenue expected during the biennium based on the present law. Please note, these two amounts represent 60% of the total actual gaming tax received since 40% of the total actual gaming tax received is paid back to the counties and cities for gaming enforcement purposes.

EXPENSE: A one-time expense of \$2,500 would be incurred to modify the existing gaming computer programs to accommodate the provisions of this bill.

FOOTNOTE: The decrease in the general fund of \$1,977,036 for the biennium is exclusive of the fiscal effect of the Attorney General's Gaming Division's present level 1985-87 biennial appropriation of \$634,196. If Section 4 of SB 2063 is enacted, the appropriation of the Gaming Division could be funded by the state gaming enforcement fund, decreasing the funding needed from the general fund for this purpose. Therefore, the net fiscal effect to the general fund would be a decrease of \$1,342,840 (\$1,977,036 minus \$634,196).
