Narrative:

This bill appropriates an amount, not to exceed \$200,000, to the attorney general's operating budget for gaming enforcement purposes. The appropriation is contingent, dollar for dollar, on the general fund's share of the gaming tax collected exceeding the tax collected during the 1985-87 biennium.

Note: The attorney general's office has determined that the actual gaming general fund revenue may exceed the previous 1987-89 biennium projections by approximately \$182,532.
