Narrative:

The North Dakota Board of Barber Examiners is a self supporting Board with our own bank Account. We disperse of these funds by paying milage to meetings, conducting Examinations, and conducting shop inspections of Barber Shops and the North Dakota Barber Assoc. receives \$5.00 per Licensed Barber.

This bill would not bring any extra money into our business or would not cost our board any extra money. Their is a \$150.00 Charge to obtain a ND license under reciprocity. But anyone coming into the state has the option of also taking the examination which would cost them \$20.00 for the Examination and \$25.00 for the license.

This bill would make it more conveyent for a Barber from another state to obtain a license in North Dakota or a Barber from North Dakota to obtain a license in another State. At the present time their are 20 states that offer Reciprocity.
