Narrative:

The fiscal impact to the Bureau is to more nearly cover the actual cost of inspecting boilers and issuing inspection certificates. To fail to collect the proper amount means supplementing these costs from the Bureau's Fund, which comes from employers' premiums.

The bill would allow the Bureau to set rates for boiler fees where necessary, without running into the \$35.00 limit.

The estimated revenue which the Bureau would need to pay the cost of boiler inspections would total \$32,000 annually, or \$64,000 for the biennium in additional necessary revenue. The estimate is based on fees and costs for FYE 1986.
