In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this measure:

Narrative:

There is an overall savings based on the following benefit changes:

- A. Changing the ratio to determine the weekly benefit amount from 1/52nd of the two high quarters to 1/54th (savings).
- B. Changing the minimum benefit amount based on 18 times the federal minimum wage to 13 times (cost).
- C. Changing the percent that determines the maximum weekly benefit amount to 62% (effective 7/1/87) to 65% (effective 7/1/88) and to 67% (effective 7/1/89) (savings).

The net fiscal impact is a savings to state and local governments. The latter could not be broken out into county and city sectors.


