Narrative:

SB 2181 primarily concerns billing arrangements involving special fund agencies and the attorney general's office. If enacted, SB 2181 would allow the attorney general's office, a general fund agency, to bill and to collect monies from special fund agencies for legal services rendered. Such monies would be deposited into the attorney general's operating fund. Thus, there would be no income directly into the general fund, although the funding of the attorney general's office by the general fund would be reduced accordingly.

The estimates below of additional revenue are based upon a survey of legal services provided to special fund agencies by the attorney general's office.
