Narrative:

The estimated fiscal impact of SB 2188 is \$0. An appropriation of \$250,000 for coal research is included as a line item in the appropriation for the commissioner of university & school lands in HB 1019.

There is no provision in SB 2188 for payment to lignite development commission members for per diem allowances or necessary expenses incurred while attending commission meetings. It is anticipated that advisory commission members from the lignite related industries and businesses will serve without reimbursement for expenses. Advisory council members that are state officials or employees will serve as part of their regular duties.
