Narrative:

Fees for three types of fishing licenses are increased. The cost of a resident fishing license is increased from six to nine dollars. The resident husband and wife fishing license fee is increased from ten to thirteen dollars. The nonresident short-term fishing license fee is increased from eight to thirteen dollars. The effective date is May 7, 1988. These funds are needed to match new Federal Aid revenue and to make the fishery division financially self-sufficient.

The amendment to the bill will not increase or decrease revenue. The changes offset each other.
