Narrative:

The amendment to SB 2262 deletes the requirement that snowmobile dealers register each snowmobile sold; and adds exemptions from registration for snowmobiles operated upon lands owned or leased by the snowmobile owner and snowmobiles incapable of speeds in excess of ten miles per hour and with an engine displacement of less than one hundred cubic centimeters.

SB 2262 as amended will have very minimal state fiscal effect. It requires that fees collected from safety courses be deposited to the Snowmobile Trails Tax Fund. The snowmobile safety training course allows persons twelve to sixteen years of age without a valid driver's license to legally operate a snowmobile outside the lands owned by the person's parent or guardian.
