Narrative:

Senate Bill 2456 has an unknown fiscal note. Approval has been requested for 13 home schools for the 1986-87 school year and approval request forms have been sent to others and not returned.

Our best estimate is that it should not exceed 200 pupils per year and most would be elementary students.

This fiscal note uses a weighting factor of 1.0 which is the weighting factor for elementary schools of 100 or less and also for grades 7-8. It also uses the current \$1370 per unit payment.
