Narrative:

Approximately 25,000 additional three dollar habitat restoration stamps would be sold each year. This would provide \$75,000 per year in additional revenue for the Habitat Restoration Fund.

Annually about \$20,000 per year from art print sales would go to the Habitat Restoration Fund. This money is now going into the Game and Fish Operating Fund.

Interest revenue on the Habitat Restoration Fund is presently credited to the Habitat Restoration Fund. This bill would continue this procedure.
