Narrative:

House Bill #1020, specifically the Honey Promotion Fund and the Turkey Fund which are administered by the department of agriculture, has no fiscal effect on the state's general fund. Money appropriated for these funds is derived from the honey and turkey checkoffs, and is not dependent upon any state general fund appropriation.

The Honey Promotion Checkoff Fund limit, set at \$36,000, has not been increased from the 87-89 biennium. The Turkey Promotion Fund checkoff limit, however, has been increased from \$34,000 to \$40,000.
