Narrative:

The funds to support the State Seed Department are derived from services performed for the agricultural industry. All of the interest money on the Revolving Fund should be credited to this fund. The Department pays for all intergovernmental services which is approximately \$7,000.00 per year. The fund should earn \$50,000.00 per year in interest money. Twenty percent of the interest money would be \$10,000.00 which would be a fair exchange for governmental services. If this amendment is to be passed, the Department should not be billed for intergovernmental services.
