Narrative:

REVENUE: This bill applies a state tax rate of 1.5% on a gaming organization's actual gross proceeds and also enables the counties and cities in which gaming occurred to assess an optional tax of .5% on a gaming organization's actual gross proceeds.

This bill also continues a \$200,000 special appropriation to the attorney general's office for gaming enforcement purposes.

EXPENSE: A one-time expense of about \$10,000 would be incurred to modify the gaming computer system to reflect the provisions of this bill.
