HB 1119 Provides further authority for the Bureau to adopt fee schedules for medical services, and provides that the medical care provider may not bill the injured worker for costs over those allowed in the fee schedule. It is estimated that annual savings will be \$400,000 - \$500,000 depending on the fee schedule adopted.


