Narrative:

According to a report from the Office of Management & Budget dated October 6, 1988, there are only two full-time equivalent (FTE) employees in state government who work fewer than 20 hours (50% FTE) and more than 17 hours (42.5% FTE). Assuming these employees elected to have family coverage, the additional cost would need to be included in the budgets for the agencies employing those two individuals. The amounts indicated below assume the funds for the agencies involved are appropriated from the general fund and not special funds.


