Through the three to four percent withheld by the state from the pari-mutuel pool of each horserace or SIMULCAST of a horserace licensed by the Racing Commission, it is projected by Christianson and Cummings Associates, Inc. that the state will receive \$559,968 in the worst case scenerio or \$1,123,031 in the most likely case.
