Narrative:

REVENUE: Enables local governing bodies to charge gaming organizations up to \$25 for each local permit. Presently, local governing bodies may only charge gaming organizations \$10 for the first local permit and \$25 for the second local permit.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund -0-; Counties/Cities \$12,600.

Elininates a site permit fee tax credit that gaming organizations have applied against the gaming tax on the tax return.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$19,000; Counties/Cities \$13,000.

Enables the attorney general to impose monetary fines on gaming organizations, distributors, and manufacturers.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$50,000; Counties/Cities -0-.

Changes the method in which gaming organizations charge players for playing draw and stud poker. Enables organizations to charge players on a time buy-in method - a fee not to exceed two dollars per half hour of playing time.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$750; Counties/Cities \$500.

Classifies cash shorts as an expense from adjusted gross proceeds (part of the 45% expense limitation) rather than as an expense toward adjusted gross proceeds.

Biennium Fiscal Effect: General Fund \$29,000; Counties/Cities \$19,000.
