Narrative:

House Bill 1197 will transfer the licensure responsibility for Basic Care Facilities from the Department of Human Services to the State Department of Health and Consolidated Laboratories. This transfer is part of the Governor's effort to consolidate several functions carried out by the Department of Human Services with the certification and licensure responsibilities performed by the State Department of Health. The workload in carrying out this activity is equivalent to approximately 1 FTE but is included with other Medicaid functions.

There is no fiscal impact from this measure, since it only represents a transfer of responsibility.
