Narrative:

The transfer of the School for the Deaf, School for the Blind, and the State Library effective January 1, 1990, would have a minimal fiscal effect on the agencies and on the Director of Institutions (DOI) appropriation included in HB 1005. Currently the appropriations for the school for the deaf (HB 1006), school for the blind (HB 1006), and the state library (HB 1007), are separate from DOI and should remain separate and therefore would not be affected by HB 1229.

Travel funds are included in DOI's budget to allow for DOI staff to visit the School for the Deaf and School for the Blind during the biennium. Based on the Executive Recommendation for travel, approximately \$5,000 could be transferred from DOI (HB 1005) to the Department of Public Instruction (HB 1002) if HB 1229 is adopted with an effective date of January 1, 1990.
