Narrative:

Currently taxidermy licenses cost \$4.00 per year. This bill would provide a novice taxidermy license at no cost and a commercial taxidermy license costing \$15.00. In 1988 there were 164 licensed taxidermists in North Dakota. Taxidermy license revenue was \$656.00. Revenue under HB 1279 is estimated to increase by about \$1,000.00 per year.
