Narrative:

House Bill No. 1286 prohibits payment by the state of occupational or professional license, certificate, or membership fees for state officers and employees required for the practice of that occupation or profession. Based on a survey of state agencies and institutions employing people who must be licensed as required either by state law or as a condition of employment, the expenditures for such certificates, licenses, and memberships is estimated to be \$82,107 - \$64,054 general fund and \$18,053 special funds. This reflects a survey of the 57 agencies which have employees who would be subject to an occupational or professional license, certificate, or membership. Of the 57 agencies surveyed, 31 currently pay these fees.
